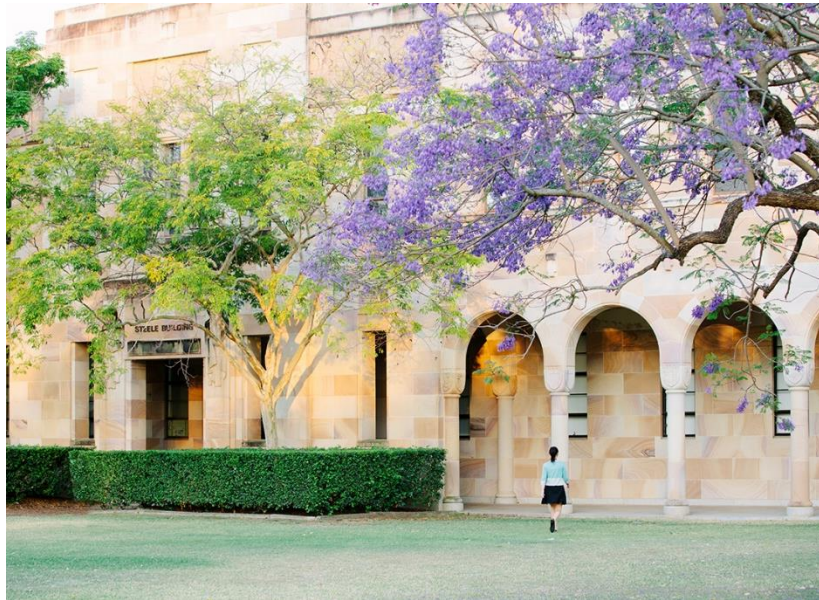

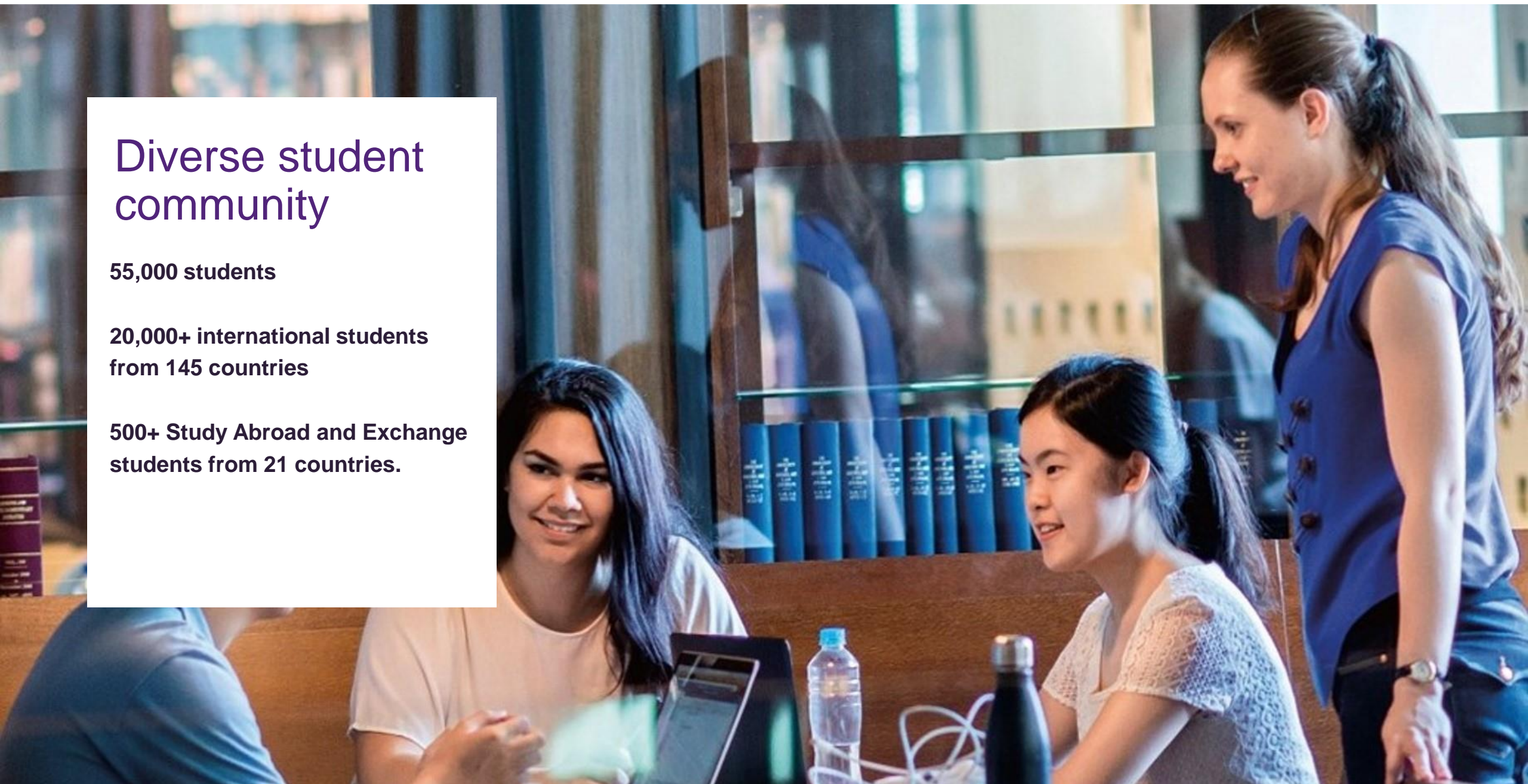

Entry Requirements

Academic

- Complete minimum 2.5 years of nursing study at CGUST
- Minimum Cumulative GPA 67%

English

- IELTS 7 overall with min 7 in each sub-band, or
- TOEFL 100 overall, W: 27, R & L: 25, S: 23 or
- Pearson 72 overall with min 72 in each sub-band

- Apply for Study Abroad program [Program Code 1062]
- Select your courses: HLTH1000, NURS1202, NURS2105
- Upload a copy (PDF) of your official Study Abroad Nomination Letter
- Upload a copy (PDF) of your official current university transcript (Sem 1 – 5)
- Upload a copy (PDF) of your passport or National ID Card
- You can submit your IELTS/TOEFL later
- Accept your offer once all conditions have been met
- Pay your deposit to obtain your electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE), which you need to apply for your student visa
- You may wish to apply via a [UQ-approved agent](#), who can also assist with visa & accommodation
